


Chrome:


- 1. Click on the Resources tab and locate the file titled Evidence of Learning. Click on it.

4. Close the EOL tab by clicking the "X," located at the top of the screen.








- Firefox:

4. Click • in the upper right-hand corner of the screen.






5. Click the downloaded file.
