

You do not need to submit an Evidence of Learning for a Child Care Aware® of North Dakota e-Learning course that is classified as “Registered – Not for Career Pathways Placement.” Instead, you will be prompted to answer quiz questions throughout the course and must receive a score of 80% or higher to receive credit. 
